BRIGHT STRAW YELLOW WITH GREENISH HUES. THE BOUQUET IS FRAGRANT, WITH HINTS OF PINEAPPLE, PEACH, AND A NOTE OF APRICOT. RICH AND FULL IN THE MOUTH WITH A LONG FRUITY AND PERSISTENT AFTERTASTE.

WHITE WINE OF GREAT ELEGANCE, IT IS PRODUCED WITH THE CORTESE GRAPE VARIETAL GROWN IN THE PRE- APENNINES HILLS OF THE GAVI VILLAGE. THESE HILLS, WHICH ARE LOCATED BETWEEN PIEDMONT AND LIGURIA, ARE FAVOURED BY CLIMATIC CONDITIONS ABLE TO EXPRESS THE VERY BEST ORGANOLEPTIC CHARACTERISTICS OF THE VARIETAL.
